In accordance with the provisions of § 147-22.1, the stopping, standing or parking of a vehicle in the locations described below, which are hereby designated as places for handicapped parking, is prohibited, unless the vehicle bears a permit issued under § 1203-a or registration issued under § 404-a of the New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law and such vehicle is being used for the transportation of a severely disabled or handicapped person: Handicap parking spot in front of 61 Hickory Rd, Village of Manorhaven New York (Amendment to Sec. 147-52 Schedule XVI: Handicapped Parking).
