- Sherry Denn
 - o Is there an update on the Moratorium
 - o Attorney Neumann stated that the NC Planning Commission had comments on the Moratorium and that the Village will respond to those comments.
 - o Moratorium has been filed with NY State
- Christine Zahn
 - 22 Sagamore Hill Drive a door on the building has broken glass and has been neglected for several months
 - Residents of 22 Sagamore Hill Drive are walking dogs with no leashes, which is a safety hazard and against Village code
 - o A portion of the roof at 22 Sagamore Hil Drive is damaged
 - o Builder should be held accountable for issues and upkeep of property.
 - o Is there a plan for adding R1 and R2 zoning to the moratorium?
 - o Mayor stated that Village is working on zoning and will seek to add R1 and R2
- Robert Murphy
 - With reference to Resolution 62-2025, who currently owns property that is being sold?
 - o Mayor stated that currently the Village owns the property, but it is landlocked and not of any use to the Village
 - o The parcel being sold is not buildable
 - What is the status of Haven Marina project?
 - o Mayor stated that third party engineer is currently reviewing all the plans
 - o Builder has applied for Water Availability but has not yet received approval
 - o Sewer Availability study is currently under review by engineer
 - Mr. Murphy stated that he has not seen any work on the 30 Sagamore Hill Drive project. The Mayor stated that it may be some time before actual construction and work begins
- Christine Zahn
 - o In reference to Resolution 62-2025, if bulkhead is built who will have responsibility for maintenance
 - Attorney Neumann the land owner will take title and will assume all responsibility, including DEC clearance
